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Halloween Dog

Materials needed:

- Worsted weight yarn in black and a little in red
- Knitting needles US size 6 (4 mm)
- Mattress needle
- Polyester or cotton for stuffing

Abbreviations used:

R = row, k = knit, p = purl, m1 = make 1, k2tog = knit two stitches together, k3tog = knit three stitches together, m1p = make 1 purl-wise, p2tog = purl two stitches together.

Size of the toy: around 14 inches (it depends on size of the

knitting needles and how tightly you are knitting

IMPORTANT NOTE:

The toy is knitted with stockinette stitch, unless otherwise noted. The even number of the rows should be purled, unless otherwise noted, therefore we will not include the even numbers of the rows that need to be purled

HEAD, BODY and TAIL (make 1)

We will start knitting from the head side.

Cast on 9 stitches with brown yarn.

R1 knit the whole row = 9 stitches

R3 kl, $(ml, kl) \times 8$ times = 17 stitches

R5 - R9 stockinette stitch (i.e. knit odd rows and purl even rows) = 17 stitches

R11 k1, (m1, k2) x 8 times = 25 stitches

R13 - R27 Stockinette stitch - i.e. knit the odd rows and purl the even rows

R29 k1, (k1, k2tog) x 8 times = 17 stitches

this will be the neckline.





R31 k1, $(m1, k2) \times 8 \text{ times} = 25$ stitches

R33- R39 Stockinette stitch - knit odd rows and purl even rows = 25 stitches

R41 kl, ml, k23, ml, kl = 27 stitches

R43 - R71 Stockinette stitch - knit odd rows and purl even rows = 27 stitches

R73 k1, k2tog x 13 times = 14 stitches

R75 k2, k2tog x 5 times, k2 = 9 sttches

end of body - we will continue with knitting the tail

R77 - R107 stockinette stitch - knit odd rows and purl even rows

R106 slip 8 stitches over the first stitch one by one: insert the knitting needle into the second stitch and slip it over the first stitch. Now insert the knitting needle into the third stitch and slip it over the first stitch. Work the same way through 9th stitch and slip it over the first stitch as well. Now you should have only one (the first) stitch on your needle. Cast off.

LEGS (make 4)

Cast on 10 stitches with brown varn.

R1 - R15 Stockinette stitch - knit odd rows and purl even rows

R17 slip 9 stitches over the first stitch one by one: insert the knitting needle into the second stitch and slip it over the first stitch. Now insert the knitting needle into the third stitch and slip it over the first stitch. Work the same way through 10th stitch and slip it over the first stitch as well. Now you should have only one (the first) stitch on your needle. Cast off.

EARS (make 2)

We will knit ears with garter stitch - i.e. **all rows are knitted**, as odd rows as well as the even rows.

Cast on 6 stitches with brown yarn.

R1-R4 knit all of the rows (including even rows!)

R5 kl, ml, k4, ml, kl = 8 stitches

R6 - R12 knit all of the rows (including even rows)

R13 kl, ml, k6, ml, kl = 10 stitches

R14 - R28 knit all of the rows (including even rows)

R29 k1, cast off 1, k8 = 9 stitches

R30 k1, cast off 1, k7 = 8 stitches

R31 k1, cast off 2, k4 = 6 stitches

R32 cast off

HOW TO MAKE UP

Sew the sides of HEAD, BODY and TAIL piece on the wrong (purl side, leaving a small opening in the middle of the belly. Turn the piece inside out through the opening and stuff with polyester. Use a pencil to stuff the tail, too. Tie the black yarn around the neckline, tie a knot and pull tightly - this will shape the neckline.

Sew the ears onto the head, embroider eyes and mouth with red yarn.

Sew the sides of the leg on the wrong (purl) side, leaving the opening at the side to be sewn onto the body. Turn the piece inside out through the opening, stuff it and sew across. Do the same for the remaining 3 pegs and sew all of the 4 legs onto the body.
